

ABSTRACT

This report aimed to examine the problems facing military institutions towards economic growth a case of JKT-Olgoro at Arumeru district. The objectives of study were to examine the military involvement in developmental activities, to examine military necessary skills and resources available towards economic development and to examine problems facing military institutions in attaining economic growth. The study used theories and approaches so that to relate theories into practice: De facto political power and "Contra vim non valet ius". Sample size that used was 95 respondents, however only 81 responded. Both primary and secondary methods of data collection were used. The study used descriptive research design. Nevertheless, words, quotes and discussion were used to analysis data, charts, also tables, maps and photographs were used to evaluate the large extent of data. Furthermore, the study fulfills its aim by reveal the military involvement such as agriculture projects, creations of infrastructure projects, security project and socio-mobilization projects. Finally, the study concluded that, military assistance in development projects is largely possible and beneficial to society though it faces destructive problems. Furthermore, using the military could help improve the relationship between the military and civilians around the area and ultimately bolster greater cooperation among the various sectors in rural areas. The study recommended further research should be done to investigate the current impacts of technological changes to the development of military institutions in JKT or other related aspects in military.
