ABSTRACT

This research report is about the assessment if risks associated with real estate investment in Tanzania. The study has analyzed different types of risks which are associated to real estate investment like business risk, financial risk to the level of debt, inflation as another risk, interest rate risk, management risk, legislative risk, environmental risk, liquidity risk, fire and many more.
