

ABSTRACT

Although ERP systems bring competitive advantage, many organizations there is high failure rate in the implementation of such systems.

This dissertation will concern with the assessment of ERP implementation challenges and prospects. Comparative the case study approach using questionnaires and interviews and document analysis was used to presenting the issues concern ERP implementation challenges in an organization.

In the Literature Review an endeavour was made to study and provide an overview of the main contexts of the problem. The literature shows number of strategies, challenges facing ERP implementation and technical support type. Research gap is also presented.
