

ABSTRACT

The study conducted in Kigoma region using kakonko District Council and Gwarama ward. The Kigoma – Kasulu-Kibondo-Kakonko-Nyakanazi road network selected as the case to analyze the role of rural roads construction in reducing crimes in rural areas in Tanzania. Descriptive Qualitative and Quantitative analysis conducted taking into account experience of the Units along The Kigoma – Kasulu-Kibondo-Kakonko-Nyakanazi road network, in Kigoma Region, Tanzania. Data collected using the structured questionnaire and telephone interview on the specified research questions. four questions used in this study focusing on the contribution of the rural roads construction on the securing of the nation, contributions of the rural roads on reduction of the crimes, investigation of socio-economic issues associated rural roads building and finally the study measured thinking on the values the rural roads construction.
